### Project Execution

Supply of all panels, Inverter and other auxiliaries completed on 5th Dec 2023. Supply items verified by School authorities and delivery challan signed by School Principal. Material was placed in safe custody until commencement of Installation works. Installation of panels and Inverter commenced at site after receipt of sanction letter from electricity board and providing of Workmen's compensation insurance policy. Overall Installation of Inverter, panels, electrical connections, and auxiliaries was completed in 10 days. After work completion all required installation reports were submitted and approved from the electricity board. Net Meter was taken in line for Grid connection.

Branding board for the Inauguration was in scope of the supplier and was delivered at site on 8<sup>th</sup> Feb 2024 and installed on 16<sup>th</sup> Feb 2024.

The total execution time of the Project from order placement to handover including all Presanctions and final checks and approvals from electricity board was 3 months.






### **Report for the Webinar on Awareness on Child Abuse -EWB-India KGC College of Technology Student Chapter**

**Objective** –To ensure continuous supply of water to the villages of Umberpada, Saphale and Kardal villages in the State of Maharashtra, India

**Problem Statement** – Due to voltage fluctuation, the existing pumping system used to collapse and called for rewinding of the motor every other months. As these motors are 60 Hp hence took a lot of time to get the same repaired and thereby no water supply to the residents of the above said villages.

Also the motors of the pump in the water treatment plant for supplying the treated water to the Master Balancing Reservoir (MBR) was very old and due to frequent repair was not working as required.

**Project Need** – Upon detailed study of the issue in this existing system, it was found that with providing an adequate level of automation and pump/motor control devices will take care of the voltage fluctuations and safeguard the motor from wear and tear.

**Implementation** – The existing pumpong system was refurbished by providing new 60 HP motor along with Variable Frequency Drive (VFD) at the pump jack Well and a new 50 HP motor at the water treatment plant.

**Outcome** – The autoation to the existng system with new motrs not only in achieving efficiencys (low power bill) but the takes care of the voltage fluctuation and helps protecting the motor from damage.

**Impact** – Continious supply of water to the 20000 residents of the village in Saphale.
